Media Award

1. The ACNP Media Award was established in 2002 to honor a member of the print or electronic media who has made a major contribution to the education of the public about mental illness and substance abuse research and the positive impact of research on treatment. The award is intended to be an expression of appreciation from the College toward outstanding leaders in the media who provide complete, accurate, and unbiased information to our society about brain diseases. Furthermore, as a result of attending the ACNP Annual Meeting and interacting with members, the honoree will further develop his/her own knowledge of the field and will expand his/her network of expert contacts.
2. The Media Award consists of an expense paid trip to the ACNP Annual Meeting in Miami Beach, Florida, December 5th-9th, 2010 and a plaque to be presented at the ACNP Annual Meeting during the President's Plenary. The Award winner must attend the Annual Meeting.
3. Any individual may submit a nomination for the ACNP Media Award by submitting to the Awards Committee:
 - a. A nominating statement no longer than three pages in length that describes the contributions made by the candidate.
 - b. No more than three examples of the person's work (articles, CD's, DVD's, books, etc.) as supporting material. *See note below for submission instructions.
 - c. Be sure to include the exact name, title, and contact information of the nominee.
